Worship

Every Sunday at 10:00am - In Person & Online

Trinity has a 10:00am worship start time. Join us in the Sanctuary, on Zoom or via YouTube for worship services featuring a diverse blend of preaching, music and prayer that appeals to a variety of ages.

The first Sunday of each month will be an inter-generational worship service that includes communion and emphasizes opportunities for worshippers of all ages to participate. About four times a year, the first Sunday will be a special "Milestone Sunday" when we celebrate milestone moments in the lives of our members.

The second to fifth Sundays of the month, children ages Pre K to 5th grade will start in the Sanctuary with their families and then have the choice to go to class upstairs: Children & Worship (Pre K to 2nd grade) or Kids Connect (3rd to 5th grade).





All grown-ups need to register their child or youth before they participate in any Faith Formation class to ensure we have their latest health & safety info. A check-in area located outside the Sanctuary near the Prayground has info and paper/digital forms.



Children & Worship Faith Formation

2nd to 5th Sundays from 10:15am-11:15am | Pre K to 2nd Grade

Kiddos ages Pre K to 2nd grade attend worship with their grown-ups through the Children's Moment and then have the choice to go upstairs for Children & Worship. This class meets in the Children & Worship Room with check-out in the gathering area outside the elevator on the 2nd floor.

The Children & Worship curriculum has been offered at Trinity for many years and is a Montessori-style experience that focuses on the stories of our faith. The class is led by Sue Sundheimer, Greg Longworth, Laura Johns & other Safe Sanctuary certified leaders.

NEW: Kids Connect Faith Formation

2nd to 5th Sundays from 10:15am-11:15am | 3rd Grade to 5th Grade

Kiddos ages 3rd to 5th grade attend worship with their grown-ups through the Children's Moment and then have the choice to go upstairs for our Kids Connect class.

This class meets in the TrinityKids Room with check-out in the gathering area outside the elevator on the 2nd floor.

Kids Connect encourages older elementary students to connect with God's big story through quirky humor-filled videos, Bible exploration, and hands-on projects. The class is led by Jane Hazle, Amy Hineline, Jessie Takala, Laura Johns & other Safe Sanctuary certified leaders.



Staffed Nursery

Every Sunday from 9:00am-12:30pm

The nursery is open an extended period each Sunday to allow grown-ups to participate in everything from band and choir practice to worship to Faith Formation.

The nursery is down the hall from the Sanctuary on the main floor and is designed for infants through Pre K children. It's staffed by Safe Sanctuary certified paid employees and screened volunteers. Our leaders focus on creating a safe environment for engaging our littlest friends with stories, music, art and more.

TrinityKids: Fellowship

Ages Pre-K to 5th Grade

Kiddos start their morning at Trinity by participating in the more structured and reflective inter-generational worship service, the Children & Worship Class, or the Kids Connect Class. TrinityKids Fellowship is an opportunity to crank up the volume and the activity level. Get ready for gym time, game time, dance parties, sing-alongs, crafts, science & more!

This program begins in the TrinityKids (formerly Sound Beat) Room upstairs at 11:30am. Just like with during worship classes, all kiddos will need to be registered ahead of time and dropped off / picked up by an authorized grown-up. The class may venture to other parts of the church during the Faith Formation Hour, but pick-up will be back in the TrinityKids Room. The program will be led by Safe Sanctuary Certified leaders.

Youth Group: Fellowship

6th to 12th Grade

Join us each week for a youth experience that focuses on relationship building – with ourselves, with each other, and with God. There will be conversation, games, activities, gym time, and more!

Youth Group meets in the upstairs Pellowe Room at 11:30am and is led by our Youth Programing Director Jeremy Farkas. Information on a self-guided Confirmation Study and other youth opportunities is on the website.

Ages 18 and Up

Family Spaces

The Prayground in the back of the Sanctuary is designed to give families of all types a comfortable space to worship together. It features quiet toys, books, and activities as well as supplies for infants and breast-feeding parents. It also incorporates materials that can be taken back to a pew if desired.

In the Fireside Room, comfortable chairs and a portable Prayground are available for any grown-ups that wish to find a space outside the Sanctuary to use with their kiddos. The service live-stream will be available on the SmartTV.

Every Sunday from 9:30am-11:45am

Gather in the Parlor before worship for coffee and tea. Take a lidded cup into the Sanctuary. Return to the Parlor after worship for additional fellowship time, drinks, and snacks. Sometimes we all need a little caffeine and calories to get us through our Sunday morning!


